Who: College/university professors or lecturers interested in attending the Western Users of SAS® Software (WUSS) 2018 Conference and meeting each of the following six criteria:

1. Employed with a teaching or research assignment during the 2018–2019 academic year at an accredited degree-granting institution in the WUSS region (Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming)
2. Planning to use SAS® for teaching or research during the 2018–2019 academic year
3. Able to provide proof of teaching/research assignment via an official letter from their institution
4. Not previously a WUSS faculty scholarship awardee
5. Willing to volunteer as a session or class coordinator (this requires a 4-hour commitment, with details provided to scholarship awardees)
6. Will be presenting a paper (not a Quick Tips or Posters) at WUSS 2018¹

What: Scholarship awardees will receive complimentary conference registration, lodging, one free half-day class (Wed AM or Fri PM), and travel funding

Where and When: September 5–7, 2018, at the Hyatt Regency in Sacramento, California
